A regular meeting of the Fruitland City Council was held at Fruitland City Hall on the above date at 7:00 P.M.

PRESENT: Ken Bishop, Bud Reifsnyder, Stuart Grimes, Reece Hrizuk.

ABSENT: Ed Pierson.

OTHERS PRESENT: Jeff Carpenter, Dana Carpenter, Lucinda Day, April Ehrlich, Dwayne Holloway, Jerry Campbell, JD Huff, Steve Mazingo, and Suzanne Percy.

Mayor Bishop called the meeting to order and roll was taken.

Councilman Grimes moved to approve the April 13, 2015 minutes. Seconded by Councilman Reifsnyder. Motion carried.

Citizen Requests-

Lucinda Day, 245 SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, owner of Big Sky Sportswear stated she has been rethinking her previous request for a loading zone to be located on the Iowa Avenue side of her business. She thinks the loading zone would keep her customers from parking at her business and in doing so would defeat the purpose. Mrs. Day would like to hang a sign asking for "Big Sky Customer Parking Only." The sign would be hung under the second floor platform area. Chief Huff will check the sign code as it pertains to her proposal.

City Engineer Reports –

Zach Piepmeyer, Transportation Engineer – Written report.

Councilman Hrizuk moved to approve the Transportation Engineer report. Seconded by Councilman Grimes. Motion carried.

Mayor Bishop announced that City of Fruitland was ranked No. 2 for the Land & Water Conservation Fund grant. The Crestview Park Project will be recommended to the Idaho Parks & Recreation Board for funding.

Carl Hipwell, Water/Sewer Engineer - Written report.

Councilman Grimes moved to approve the Water/Sewer Engineer report. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried.

The Council reviewed an equipment maintenance agreement between the City of Fruitland and Cummins Rocky Mountain, LLC for the emergency generator located at City Hall. Councilman

Grimes moved to approve the generator maintenance agreement. Seconded by Councilman Reifsnyder. Motion carried.

Councilman Grimes moved to read Ordinance No. 599 - Comprehensive Plan Amendment/Rezone - 800 Block N. Pennsylvania Avenue, by title only. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried. Councilman Grimes moved approve the first reading, suspend the rules and adopt Ordinance No. 599. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Roll call vote: Grimes, aye. Hrizuk, aye. Reifsnyder, aye. Motion carried.

The Council reviewed a memo from City Administrator, Rick Watkins regarding the Parks & Trails committee sign ups. Twenty-nine individuals have offered to serve on the Parks & Trails Committees. Watkins recommends deferring actual appointments and general meeting of the committee members until the "*Focus on Fruitland*" newsletter can be distributed the end of May with another request for committee participation to be due Friday, June 19, 2015. The Council will have the updated list to consider at their June 22<sup>nd</sup> City Council meeting. This will also allow time to get material together and usable for each individual committee. The Council agreed to wait until the June 22, 2015 City Council meeting to make appointments.

Councilman Grimes moved to cancel the May 25, 2015 City Council meeting due to Memorial Day. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried.

Councilman Grimes moved to approve the March 2015 Finance Report. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried.

Councilman Reifsnyder moved to adjourn. Seconded by Councilman Grimes. Motion carried at 7:23 P.M.
