A regular meeting of the Fruitland City Council was held at Fruitland City Hall on the above date at 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Bishop called the meeting to order and roll was taken.

Councilman Grimes moved to approve the June 8, 2015 minutes. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried.

Citizen Request-

Jack Little, 110 NW 4<sup>th</sup> Street:

- Accolades on SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Street from alumni attending high school reunions.
- Johnson Road overlay with asphalt looks very nice. Weeds & trash are terrible on properties along Johnson Road and needs cleaned up.
- NW 4<sup>th</sup> Street connection from N. Pennsylvania Avenue to US-95. Needs this connection between W. 1st Street & NW 16<sup>th</sup> Street for emergency vehicle access to different areas of town if streets are obstructed by trains.
- Would like a cul-de-sac built on NW 4<sup>th</sup> Street east of Farmers Canal.

City Engineer Reports –

Zach Piepmeyer, Street/Transportation Engineer – Written report.

Councilman Pierson moved to approve the Street/Transportation Engineer report. Seconded by Councilman Grimes. Motion carried.

Carl Hipwell, Water/Sewer Engineer - Written report.

Councilman Grimes moved to approve the Water/Sewer Engineer report. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried.

The Council reviewed the Parks & Trails Committees applications summary. Councilman Grimes moved to appoint the committees pursuant to summary results. Seconded by Councilman Pierson. Motion carried.

Proposed Resolution No. 2015-02, Amending Speed Limit on S. Kansas Avenue from 15 MPH to 25 MPH, was read at length. Councilman Pierson moved to adopt Resolution No. 2015-02. Seconded by Councilman Grimes. Roll call vote: Grimes, aye. Reifsnnyder, aye. Hrizuk, aye. Pierson, aye. Motion carried.

The Council reviewed a Computer Security Training Proposal offered by KnowBe4. The emphasis is on training people to recognize phishing emails and/or social engineering efforts which attempt to persuade the user to click on a link to malware. This training is reinforced by the use of test emails that try to trick the user into clicking a link; then monitoring the responses to the test emails. Councilman Pierson moved to approve the training proposal. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried.

The Council agreed to schedule the 2015-16 Budget Workshop for July 13, 2015 at 5:30 P.M.

Councilman Pierson moved to approve the May 2015 Finance Report. Seconded by Councilman Grimes. Motion carried.

Councilman Pierson moved to enter into Executive Session pursuant to I.C 67-2345(1)(b)-Personnel at 7:31 P.M.

The Council came out of Executive Session at 8:09 P.M.

Councilman Pierson moved to accept the resignation of Steve Mozingo, Ambulance Director, effective 9-1-2015. Seconded by Councilman Hrizuk. Motion carried.

Councilman Hrizuk moved to adjourn. Seconded by Councilman Grimes. Motion carried at 8:10 P.M.
