


PLOT PLAN EXAMPLE




Please create and submit a plan for the property in which you are applying for a building permit by showing the property line boundaries along with all existing and proposed structures. Your drawing does not have to be to scale, but must be an accurate portrayal of an overhead view of the property.

Indicate the following:

1. The boundary lines and size of the property.
2. The property address as well as the names of the streets.
3. Draw existing structures on the property using a solid line. Indicate the size of the existing structures. A structure is anything on the property that takes up lot coverage (house, deck, gazebo, shed, pool, fence, etc.).
4. Draw the proposed structure using a dotted line and mark as proposed. Indicate the size of the proposed structure.
5. Indicate the distance from the property lines to the existing structures closest to the property lines.
6. Indicate the distance between the proposed structure and the existing structures closest to it.
7. Indicate the distance from the proposed structure to the property lines.
