PERMIT CONDITIONS

I understand no more than 3 permits may be issued to one residence and/or family household and/or business location during any calendar year. If members of more than one residence join in requesting a permit, then such permit shall be considered as having been issued for each and all of such residences. _____ *(init)*

For sales in a commercial or industrial zone, the sale must be sponsored and conducted by the business located on such property. _____ *(init)*

No permit issued may be used by a person other than the one to whom the license is issued or a person named in the permit. _____ *(init)*

Permit must be posted on the premises of the sale in a conspicuous place so as to be seen by the public and officers of the Fruitland Police Department. _____ *(init)*

Sales shall be limited to no more than 3 consecutive days, hours of operation between 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. _____ *(init)*

Property offered for sale shall not be displayed on any public right of way, (streets, borrow pits, alleys or swales.) _____ *(init)*

Two signs of not more than 4' shall be permitted to be displayed on the property of the residence of the sale. _____ *(init)*

Four directional signs of not more than 2 square feet each are permitted; provided that permission to post said sign is received from the property owner. Signs shall not be posted on utility poles, power poles, telephone poles, street signs or public right of ways. No sign shall be exhibited for more that two days prior to the day the sale is to commence. All signs must be removed within 24 hours of the termination of the sale. _____ *(init)*

No signs, advertising or promotional information displayed from the bed, roof, grill or hood of a motor vehicle while the vehicle is parked in a public or street right of way. _____ *(init)*

The following placement of signs near public right-of-ways will be allowed after the property owner has given permission:

1. On streets without sidewalks, public walkways or bike paths, signs shall be placed at least 10' behind the curb or the edge of the pavement.
2. On streets with sidewalks, public walkways or bike paths, signs shall be placed at least 10' behind the curb and shall be placed behind any sidewalk, public walkway or bike path.
3. On U.S. HWY 95, which is also known as North and South Whitley Drive and on U.S. HWY 30, which is also known as NW 16th Street and is west of US-95, signs shall be at least 10' behind the curb or 10' behind the edge of pavement if there is no curb.
4. At the junction U.S. HWY 95 and U.S. HWY 30, which is Gayway Junction, signs shall be at least 20' behind the curb measured at the radius. _____ *(init)*
