A special meeting of the Fruitland City Council was held at the Payette County Courthouse, 1130 3rd Avenue North, Payette, ID on the above date at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of an Area of Impact Negotiations Committee workshop.

Mark Shigeta declared a conflict of interest as he is on the Gas & Oil Board of Commissioners and excused himself from discussions, leaving the workshop.

The remaining members of the Negotiations Committee reviewed Fruitland City Code-Title 10, Chapter 19- Oil and Gas Operations and Payette County Code- Title 8, Chapter 20- Oil and Gas Drilling. After review and comparison of both codes, the committee members agreed to the overall acceptance of Fruitland City Code-Title 10, Chapter 19- Oil and Gas Operations with the exception of adding Payette County Code- Title 8, Chapter 20, section 7-J. Weed/Debris Control: The site shall be kept in a clean condition, free from weeds, debris and rubbish of every character. The well site should remain vegetation free.

The members agreed to review the first draft of the proposed impact area ordinance, for discussions at the next meeting.

The next workshop was scheduled for May 2, 2022 at 3:00 P.M. to be held at the Payette County Courthouse.
