A special meeting of the Fruitland City Council was held at Broken Bowl Catering, 222 N. Plymouth Avenue, New Plymouth, ID at 6:00 P.M. for the purpose participating in the Payette County Summit.

The purpose of the Summit was to facilitate a comprehensive discussion among the leaders of Payette County regarding shared concerns and formulate solutions beneficial to all residents of Payette County.

The participants shared key issues impacting the Payette County Community such as the aging/inadequate jail and 911 equipment, a proposed jail bond, inadequate ambulance facilities, landfill issues, Emergency Management Services, and proposed impact fees and funding mechanisms.
