

## Notice of Public Hearing on Proposed Grant Activities

The City of Fruitland is submitting a proposal to the Idaho Local Highway Technical Assistance Council for a Local Federal-aid Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) in the approximate amount of \$2,900,000. The proposed project is to construct needed infrastructure improvements that will reconstruct North Pennsylvania Avenue from NE 11<sup>th</sup> Street to NW 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Improvements will include improving/widening intersection at NW 16<sup>th</sup> Street to include dedicated turn lanes, addition of curb, gutter, sidewalk, and storm water drainage.

The hearing will include a discussion of the application, scope of work, budget, schedule, benefits of the project, how STBG funds will benefit the residents of the City of Fruitland, and location of the proposed project. The STBG application and related documents will be available for review.

The hearing has been scheduled for January 9th, 2023 at 7:00 P.M. at Fruitland City Hall. Verbal and written comments will be accepted prior to and at the hearing.
